Purpose of the paper

To present for noting, the NHS England Medium Term Planning Framework, the ICBs associated primary care commissioning intentions and work programmes.

Executive summary

The Medium-Term Planning Framework (MTPF) is an ambitious document. It builds on the 10 Year Health Plan and sets out how the NHS can deliver the three shifts and the new way of working:

- Hospital to community
- Analogue to digital
- Sickness to prevention

It aims to reduce waiting times dramatically, restore access to local care to the level patients and communities expect, and slash unnecessary bureaucracy so that savings are poured back into frontline services and staff.

This slide set draws out the key expectations for primary care and aligns to these the ICB's primary care commissioning intentions and related work programmes. In addition there is a range of BAU activity which also underpins the our response to the MTFP.
