<b>Purpose of the paper</b>		
To update the Sub-committee on the work recently undertaken to review and refresh the primary care road maps and seek feedback.		
<b>Executive summary</b>		
<p>The Lancashire and South Cumbria Roadmap 2030 identifies priorities for 2025/26 and beyond. These priorities include intermediate care, managing long-term conditions in primary care, improving end-of-life care and frailty in addition to delivering transformation in the way we provide cancer, mental health, children and young people's services, acute and elective care.</p> <p>This wider road map was informed by the development of several underpinning road maps, including for General Practice, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Eye Care.</p> <p>These road maps have recently been subject to rapid review and refresh, including engagement, to inform the Lancashire and South Cumbria Clinical Strategy currently being developed. This review has included an update and alignment to the Commissioning Intentions and NHS England Medium Term Planning Framework.</p>
