Workforce Development Fund

The fund allows you to claim back money towards the costs of workers completing a broad range of adult social care qualifications and learning programmes.

Workforce Development Fund 2019-20 - The Workforce Development Fund (WDF) for 2019-20 is funding from the Department of Health and Social Care (DHSC) disseminated by Skills for Care. It supports the provision of high quality care and the continuing professional development (CPD) of staff across the adult social care sector by providing a contribution towards the costs of vocational learning. How to claim funding directly from Skills for Care- You will need to meet the NMDS-SC account requirements for WDF and submit a claim.

Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT)

The Data Security and Protection Toolkit (DSPT) <u>https://www.dsptoolkit.nhs.uk</u> is an online self-assessment tool for data security which enables care providers to have access to NHS mail for the secure transfer of care information between health and social care providers.



SHADOW - End of life tool for care providers

We know that when people have been identified as approaching the last year or so of life and have a care plan reflecting their wishes and preferences this has been shown to improve the quality of life in the last year, months, weeks and days and beneficial for all of those involved in their care. 'SHADOW' has been developed for care home staff to improve confidence and ability to recognise those residents approaching the end of life. It provides a systematic and proactive approach to early identification which ultimately triggers multidisciplinary support, discussion, planning and the completion of a care plan and other related documentation.
