Service Specification Review

Greater Preston CCG, Chorley and South Ribble CCG, Morecambe Bay CCG, Fylde & Wyre CCG and Blackpool CCG have been successful with their business cases commissioning an integrated community stroke rehabilitation service.

A joint review of the service specification is now being undertaken to support and reflect the new service. Several task and finish groups have taken place to facilitate this process and further engagement with staff will be taking place through Autumn 2019.

A task and finish group took place on 23 September to start to map the impact of introducing artificial intelligence for imaging of stroke patients.

A service specification has now been drafted to outline clinical/technical requirements of an AI solution and an evaluation session has been arranged for 29 November to review and evaluate the AI software solutions.
