Training Videos



Establishing an Integrated Stroke Delivery Network (ISDN)

The Strategic Stroke Improvement Group are designing and delivering an Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) Breakthrough Series Collaborative. Our aim is to establish an Integrated Stroke Delivery Network for the ICS and standardise our Stroke models of care including Prevention, Urgent Care, Acute Care, Rehabilitation, Long Term Support and pathways.

We will bring together patients, clinicians, commissioners, data analysts, improvement experts, operational managers, primary care and the voluntary sector to co-design and test improved systems and processes to deliver world class stroke services and outcomes.

The Launch Event of the Breakthrough Series Collaborative took place on 18 December, the event was well attended by Stroke teams from across Lancashire and South Cumbria.

The attendees from the event were all motivated and supportive of the implementation of the ISDN.

Stroke Artificial Intelligence

A demonstration and evaluation took place on 29 November 2019 to evaluate the suppliers for Artificial Intelligence for Advanced Image Reporting and to select a preferred provider.

Lancashire and South Cumbria are working to undertake a 2 year pilot of this provision into our thrombectomy service by June 2020.

Following this pilot and its perceived outcomes, it is expected that a formal procurement of a solution will be undertaken as a national procurement roll out.
