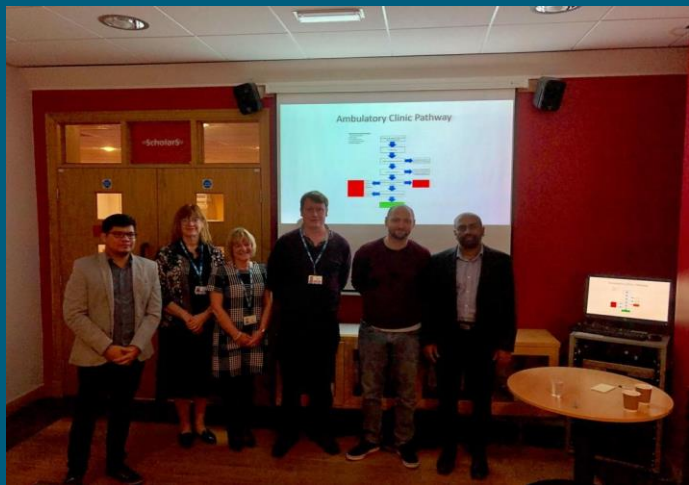
Establishing an Integrated Stroke Delivery Network (ISDN)

The Strategic Stroke Improvement Group are designing and delivering an Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI) Breakthrough Series Collaborative. Our aim is to establish an Integrated Stroke Delivery Network (ISDN) for the ICS and standardise our Stroke models of care including Prevention, Urgent Care, Acute Care, Rehabilitation, Long Term Support and pathways.

Learning session 1 took place on 08 February 2020 and the focus of this session included Prevention, Ambulatory Care Model and the ISDN measurement strategy. It was reassuring to note that all sites are moving forward with the implementation of the Ambulatory Care Model.
