Key Decisions and Actions	A statement of intent was submitted from the committee's working group to the ICP Board at its last meeting. The Board have provided feedback and some suggested some additions to this, from which the working group plan to meet to implement. A meeting is being arranged for January 2021 to undertake this.
	Also since the last ICP Board meeting, the Director of Quality and Performance/Deputy Accountable Officer for the Central Lancashire CCGs, has a meeting scheduled with the East Lancashire CCGs counter-part and Midlands and Lancashire CSU to discuss the reporting of quality metrics across the ICP. It is envisaged in the future that such metrics could be reported via the committee in common.
	Furthermore since the last ICP Board, the Board paper from NHS England and Improvement has been released which provides some further clarity and timescales with regards to commissioning reform. The impacts of this reform will need to be considered in light of the formation of the committee in common. Once the consultation phase has ended, this can be considered further.
	Lastly, the system has been directed to focus efforts on the mass vaccination programme throughout December and into the new-year. The working group members have made this a key priority and therefore scaled organisational meetings to a minimum to undertake this.
