# **BUSULFAN**

**INDICATION:** Essential thrombocytopenia

#### Prior to a course of treatment

- Check FBC, U&Es, creat, LFTs
- Discuss the need for contraception with both male and female patients. Discuss risk of infertility offer semen cryopreservation to male patients
- Written consent for course

### Prior to each prescription

- Medical review of fitness for chemotherapy exclude active infection, major changes in organ function
- Check FBC

Busulphan 2 - 4mg\* od PO for 4 weeks

## Intervals between cycles and duration of course according to response and toxicity

\* available as 2mg tablets

Prophylaxis for acute & delayed emesis	None
Other medications	None

• Dose adjusted according to response and haematological toxicity

## Dose modification for liver dysfunction

• Limited information - clinical decision
