## Executive summary

This paper provides members of the ICB Public Involvement and Engagement Advisory Committee (PIEAC) with two documents. The first is the Insight, Co-production and Engagement guide, produced by members of the Communication and Engagement team as a means of supporting commissioners, PCNs and others, in understanding and undertaking engagement activity that helps to deliver the working with people and communities strategy.

The second document is the Engagement Toolkit developed to support the Provider Collaborative with a hands-on, practical implementation guide for conducting patient and public engagement activity.

The former provides a deeper exploration of the statutory and organisational reasons for engagin and involving stakeholders in the planning, delivery and implementation of health and care services. It considers the pitfalls of not doing it well, or at all, and the benefits and general methodologies and approaches of doing it well.

The latter provides a step-by-step guide to engaging and involving patients and members of the public, identifying when this should be done, and the timescales required.

Both are dynamic documents, subject to change and development, in line with the involvement and engagement process itself.
