Thank you for your request dated 16 January 2023, which a response was sent on 6 February 2023. Following receipt of your response you raised a query regarding question 8, following further enquiries with the ICB please now find below an updated response for question 8.

1. What weighting was given to the public's views as part of the decision-making process.

Original response: Feedback received from practice patients was considered when agreeing the final service specification.

Updated response: There is not a % weighting given to public views as this was a procurement exercise and not a formal public consultation. Chorley and South Ribble CCG undertook an engagement exercise to test the appropriateness of the service specification and review any necessary changes which needed to be made. The exercise resulted in an agreement by the CCG that the service specification was appropriate.
