Under the FOI act can you tell the last time the Lancashire ICB payed the private provider HCRG .

Why did Lancashire ICB stop paying HCRG.

When did Ormskirk Hospital stop being under the control of Lancashire ICB.

Our Response:

Lancashire and South Cumbria ICB has an ongoing contractual relationship with HCRG for community and urgent care services. Accordingly, the ICB has not 'stopped' paying HCRG, and makes regular monthly payments in line with the terms of the contract.

Southport and Ormskirk Hospital NHS Trust forms part of the Cheshire and Merseyside health system and as such does not fall under the control of Lancashire and South Cumbria ICB. Lancashire & South Cumbria ICB collaborates with Cheshire and Merseyside ICB on matters pertaining to the delivery of services in West Lancashire where appropriate.
