Under the FOI act can you provide me with what the ICB plan was, and what happened to the 51 million unidentified deficit.

You have informed me [see screenshot FOI 2392] that the CCG will receive the resources to cover the deficit, but I have contacted the national framework team but still waiting for a reply on what the payment was.

The reason I ask is I am looking for accountability on taxpayers money the prime minister informs us integrity and accountability should be high on public department list.

Therefore, our original response remains unchanged for FOI-3355-LSC.
