

Lancashire and South Cumbria ICB- All Age Continuing In Care (AACC) and Individual Patient Activity (IPA)

The AACC and IPA team would like to work collaboratively with the VCFSE sector to further develop our new service model.

We have recently in- housed the AACC and IPA function (1st October 2023) and created a new ICB service model, with specific place-based teams for some elements of the service. We now also have specific teams for discharge to assess (D2A), IPA and children and young people's continuing care (CYPCC).

What is AACC and IPA?

AACC is a collective term for NHS services that provide funding for the care of individuals of all ages to meet their ongoing health and care needs.

IPA refers to packages of care/rehabilitation fully funded by the NHS which are not assessed through the AACC framework and processes.

All Continuing Healthcare (CHC), IPA and Children and Young People's Continuing Care (CYPCC) teams will have the resource for reviews and case management.
