Lancashire Partnership Against Crime (LANPAC)

have awarded over £4m to projects across the county that aim to reduce crime, tackle disorder and make our communities safer.





You can ask your local neighbourhood Policing Team to submit an application to LANPAC for funding, up to £2,500 at any time throughout the year. All submitted applications will be considered and a decision will be made within five working days.

On average, our work allows one new crime reduction project to begin almost every week. We aim to protect the vulnerable elderly and tackle crime, drug abuse, street robbery, and burglary, making people feel safer on the streets and in their homes, as well as provide a wide range of educational services and recreational opportunities to help our young people lead safe, productive lives.



Applications can only be submitted by Lancashire Constabulary employees and:

 Must impact on the constabulary purpose and objective to keep the people of Lancashire safe and be an outstanding Police Force



Applications should NOT be submitted:

- For operational equipment
- For security at schools or commercial premises
- To meet salary costs.
- Please note that Road Safety issues will not be considered a priority by the LANPAC Directors
