The local Councils in Lancashire, Blackpool and Blackburn with Darwen have commissioned an exciting new initiative, the Digital Health Schools programme. Including age-appropriate health lesson package for secondary schools and colleges across the area to access and roll out at no cost to schools. It gives students the opportunity to learn about the risks of the unregulated digital health space, how to safely find and use Apps to improve their physical and emotional health and well-being in an engaging format.

Provided by ORCHA, part of the NHS England's National Innovation Accelerator Programme, Digital Healthy Schools was trialled by a number of secondary schools in 2018. Highlevels of engagement were reported from students during lessons and later, continuing to use Apps to improve their mental and physical health. Teachers found the lessons easy to run.

The local Councils want all secondary and college students across the area to be armed with this information, helping to build resilience and tackle mental and physical health early, in line with the NHS Long Term Plan.
