Policy for Ganglia Excision	NHS Greater Preston and Chorley South Ribble CCGs	 The CCG will consider requests for surgical excision of the ganglion when all of the following criteria are satisfied: The ganglion has resulted in *significant functional impairment AND The patient is experiencing severe pain as a result of the ganglions size or position despite the use of analgesics. OR Neurovascular compromised as a result of the ganglion size or position OR Where there is concern over the diagnosis (with or without pain) Well documented evidence of significant pain that is present all or most of the time and preventing usual activities should be presented. 	NHSE EBI breaks this down into wrist and seed ganglia and mucous cysts. Aspiration of ganglia and treatment for numbness/tingling included in addition to pain
