	Options Appraisal Concept Document - Acute Frailty Unit, LTHTR The Forum welcomed Chris Endersby and members of the acute frailty service who provided a presentation outlining the ICP Concept Document and the use of the acute frailty unit as the test case for the process. Following detailed discussion the Forum strongly endorsed this case recognising the incredible work undertaken by the service and the positive impacts this has had on patients.
	Emergency Readmissions within 28 Days The Forum heard a detailed presentation from Marie Thompson of the findings and outcomes from a project undertaken to look at emergency readmissions within 28 days, this included detail of analysis around numbers, reasons for readmissions, age groups, and specialities. Further information was given regarding a clinical audit undertaken and the findings from this were outlined along with next steps and learning. Following detailed discussion there was support for undertaking the audit within primary care and also to look at how the digital service could provide support within primary care. The Forum recognised that support for patients at end of life was particularly important and how to support these patients with their choices.
	Continuing Pressures in the System The Forum discussed whether to continue with the meetings in view of the pressures in the system and the recognition that some things could be stepped down temporarily. The Forum agreed to continue the meetings with a focus on topics to support management of Covid and reduce the duration of the meeting to an hour.
