Meeting Date	12 th November 2020
Key Decisions and Actions	The inaugural meeting for the Determinants of Health SDB comprised of several key decisions and delegated actions to ensure that the Board's objectives are robust and attainable.
	It was confirmed that the purpose of the Determinants of Health SDB is to improve the health and wellbeing of our population through the reduction of inequalities.
	It was agreed amongst members that the outcomes from the work undertaken by the Board may take longer to be realised due to the nature of the aligned priority, Population Health Management. It is clear that there are short term, immediate asks that the Board is able to concentrate on that will inevitably make a positive impact, such as identifying vulnerable people at risk during the winter, especially those more susceptible to Covid.
	Part B of the Terms of Reference has been agreed, though membership is yet to be ratified. It is important for the Board to ensure that the right stakeholders are involved across the wider spectrum of ICP partner organisations to ensure the best possible outcomes.
	 The key actions taken from this meeting included; Core membership to be sought for approval at the next meeting A Task and Finish group to be mobilised to agree where the health inequalities lie across the ICP, to agree a broad framework for the direction of travel for the Board and to propose what the medium term priorities for the Board ought to be.
	 To agree some urgency in accordance with the Local Authority Hubs, the vulnerable persons list across the ICP which will link into work being undertaken by the ICP Primary and Community SDB.
